Heres the story breakdown

Fundamental Paper Education (FPE) is a web series that has a unique aesthetic, often blending cute, almost childlike designs with unsettling or even dark themes. The characters are typically paper-based and the "education" can sometimes involve bizarre or dangerous lessons. It has a distinct indie animation feel.

The SCP Foundation is a collaborative creative writing project and fictional organization documented on the SCP Foundation website. It focuses on the containment of anomalous entities, locations, and phenomena (known as "SCPs") that defy natural law. The lore is vast, ranging from terrifying monsters to reality-bending objects, and is presented in a clinical, scientific report style.

That's an excellent premise! The SCP Foundation getting wind of the missing students from Fundamental Paper Education opens up a lot of intriguing possibilities.

Here's how I imagine it could go down:

Trivia:

Mobile Task Force Sigma-9 "Valkyries"

Mobile Task Force Alpha-1 "Red Right Hand"

Designation: High Command Security and Special Operations Unit

Primary Role: O5 Council Protection, Internal Security, and Counter-Insurgency

Clearance Tier: 5 (Omega-Class Interventional Authority)

Mobile Task Force Alpha-1 "Red Right Hand" represents the apex of loyalty and lethality within the Foundation's armed forces. Mobile Task Force Epsilon-11 "Nine-Tailed Fox"

Designation: Internal Security and Containment Restoration Unit

Primary Role: Breach Response, Site Re-containment, and Tactical Assault

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Mobile Task Force Epsilon-11 "Nine-Tailed Fox" is a premier special operations unit dedicated to handling internal security breaches at standard Foundation sites. Designation: Rural Investigation and Containment Unit

Primary Role: Suburban Reconnaissance, Anomaly Retrieval, and Covert Observation

Epsilon-6 is vital for preventing "urban legends" from becoming confirmed public facts, ensuring that anomalies in the quiet corners of the world remain hidden.

Mobile Task Force Zeta-9 "Mole Rats"

Designation: Subterranean Exploration and Recovery Unit

Primary Role: Underground Reconnaissance, Structural Navigation, and Search and Rescue

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Zeta-9 "Mole Rats" is arguably the most specialized and high-risk unit in the Foundation, tasked with the exploration and containment of underground, enclosed, or inconsistent topographical environments. Operatives of Zeta-9 are trained to combat claustrophobia and navigate non-Euclidean spaces where the laws of physics and direction often fail. Equipped with closed-circuit rebreathers, heavy tactical armor, and advanced grappling and climbing gear, they venture into tunnels, mines, and anomalous structures that defy mapping. Their survival rate is notably lower than other units due to the unpredictable nature of their operational environments. During the exploration of SCP-████, a subterranean labyrinth that shifted its layout every hour, Zeta-9 successfully retrieved a lost research team that had been trapped for weeks. By utilizing distinct "breadcrumb" reality anchors, they mapped a stable escape route through the shifting stone, extracting the team before the tunnel collapsed. Zeta-9 is distinguished by their sheer grit and ability to operate in environments where GPS, radio, and standard navigation are useless, making them the masters of the underground.

Mobile Task Force Beta-7 "Maz Hatters"

Designation: Biological and Chemical Hazard Containment Unit

Primary Role: Biohazard Control, Decontamination, and Pathogen Neutralization

Clearance Tier: 3 (Alpha-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Beta-7 "Maz Hatters" is the Foundation's primary response unit for high-level biological, chemical, and radiological hazards and also a cleanup crew in postmortem operations. Named for their specialized protective gear, Beta-7 operatives are experts in epidemiology, virology, and hazardous materials handling. They are tasked with the containment of rapid-spread anomalous diseases, fungal infestations, and anomalous biological entities (such as SCP-008 or SCP-610 variants). Their equipment includes Level A HAZMAT suits with self-contained life support, incendiary weaponry for sanitation, and mobile decontamination chambers. Primary Role: Spectral Containment, Ecto-morphic Analysis, and Exorcism Tactics

Clearance Tier: 3 (Alpha-Class Interventional Authority)

Mobile Task Force Mu-13 "Ghostbusters" specializes in the tracking, analysis, and containment of incorporeal, intangible, or spectral entities. Unlike units that deal with physical monsters, Mu-13 faces threats that can pass through walls, possess human hosts, or disrupt electronic equipment. Their operatives are equipped with specialized "Gen-2" reality anchors, electromagnetic disruption grenades, and experimental spectral containment traps designed to solidify or bind intangible forms. They work closely with the Department of Spectral Phenomena to identify the nature of a haunting or possession before engaging. Mu-13 was deployed during the "Grand Hotel" phenomenon, where a spectral entity had trapped hundreds of civilians in a time-looping nightmare. Utilizing a combination of ritualistic containment protocols and high-tech electromagnetic emitters, Mu-13 managed to destabilize the entity's hold on the building, freeing the civilians and capturing the entity in a portable containment unit. Mu-13 is unique in their ability to fight the invisible, bridging the gap between paratechnology and the occult to secure threats from beyond the grave.

Mobile Task Force Gamma-7 "Spectral Vanguard"

Designation: Crisis Reinforcement and Close Quarters Specialist Unit

Primary Role: Tactical Support, Hostage Rescue, VIP Protection, and CQC Elimination

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Gamma-7 "Spectral Vanguard" is a specialized intervention unit reserved for operations that have escalated beyond standard containment parameters, specifically those involving "complicated" variables such as high civilian density, hostage situations, or compromised friendly forces. Unlike primary containment teams, Gamma-7 is rarely deployed for initial contact; they are used when a situation requires complicated precision to strategize between parties (hostiles and civilians) amidst chaos without causing damage. The unit is distinguished by its unique combat doctrine, which favors advanced Close Quarters Combat (CQC) arsenals, non-lethals, and specialized bladed weaponry. During the "Maple County" incident, Gamma-7 was deployed to a secondary school in Canada where a routine anomaly investigation had spiraled into a massacre. The school was besieged by four hostile entities: three cannibalistic humanoids masquerading as teachers and a Class-IV reality-bending anomaly capable of transfiguration and manifesting lethal spikes and tentacles. With the building in full lockdown and students trapped inside, heavy fire support was challenging without injuring civilians. Gamma-7 operatives breached the perimeter, navigating the chaotic environment to shield the students. Engaging the hostiles in close quarters, along with other task forces. They apprehended the cannibalistic threats with silent efficiency, successfully evacuating the surviving students and staff. Their performance in this highly volatile environment cemented their reputation as the ultimate safeguard when the mission becomes too complex for brute force alone.

Mobile Task Force Alpha-9 "Last Hope" (ARCHIVED)

Designation: Anomalous Humanoid Integration Unit (Defunct)

Primary Role: Humanoid Weaponization, Joint Anomaly Operations (Historically)

Clearance Tier: 4 (Historical Records Clearance)

Formerly one of the most controversial units in Foundation history, **Mobile Task Force Alpha-9 "Last Hope"** was established to train and utilize humanoid SCP objects in field operations. Prior to its disbandment, Alpha-9 was notably deployed during the "Omega-K" event, where they utilized a squad of humanoid reality benders to stabilize a collapsing dimensional pocket in Eastern Prenero, proving that controlled anomalies could effectively combat wild threats under strict supervision.

Mobile Task Force Iota-9 "0th Anti-Cult Regiment"

Designation: Cult Suppression and Esoteric Warfare Unit

Primary Role: Thaumaturgic Counter-Ops, Religious Insurgency Suppression, Artifact Seizure

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Iota-9 "0th Anti-Cult Regiment" is a heavy-response unit specifically organized to dismantle hostile anomalous religious groups, Sarkic cults, and Fifthist sects. Unlike investigative units that observe from the shadows, Iota-9 is deployed when a cult has already been identified and requires immediate, forceful dismantling. They are trained in basic counter-thaumaturgy and equipped with high-grade conceptual armor to resist cognitohazardous religious chanting or memes. Iota-9 operates with a "scorched earth" doctrine regarding sacrificial sites, ensuring that altars and summoning circles are destroyed beyond recovery to prevent future events. Iota-9 was deployed during the "Sanguine Solstice" raid, where a Neo-Sarkic cult attempted to birth a colossal flesh-entity beneath a cathedral in Prague. Utilizing incendiary conceptual weapons and disrupting the ritual's harmonic frequency, Iota-9 operatives slaughtered the cultist leadership and neutralized the gestating entity before it could breach the surface, averting a mass-casualty event.

Mobile Task Force Sigma-66 "Sixteen Tons"

Designation: Deniable Asset Combat and Attrition Unit

Primary Role: High-Casualty Engagements, Attrition Warfare, Siege Operations

Clearance Tier: [] (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Sigma-66 "Sixteen Tons" is a unique and highly controversial unit composed primarily of captured personnel from rival Groups of Interest (GOIs) and high-functioning D-Class personnel who have demonstrated exceptional combat prowess. As "expendable" elites, they are deployed into "meat-grinder" scenarios where the survival rate of standard MTF operatives is projected to be below 10%. They are used for siege warfare against hostile autonomous manufacturing facilities and to suppress mass-produced anomalous armies where quantity is the primary threat. Sigma-66 was deployed during the "Steel Horizon" incident, where an anomalous clockwork factory in the Urals began churning out thousands of hostile automatons. The unit was sent in to establish a perimeter of suppression fire that lasted for 72 hours continuously. Because the operatives were considered expendable assets, they were able to hold positions that would have been tactically abandoned by other units, grinding down the waves of automatons through sheer attrition while demolition teams infiltrated the core. Their ability to sustain overwhelming losses while achieving objectives makes them a grim but necessary tool in the Foundation's arsenal.

Mobile Task Force Gamma-6 "Deep Feeders"

Designation: Deep Sea Recovery, Aquatic Containment, Oceanic Investigation

Primary Role: High-Casualty Engagements, Attrition Warfare, Siege Operations

Clearance Tier: 3 (Alpha-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Gamma-6 "Deep Feeders" is responsible for tracking, containing, and recovering anomalies in deep-ocean environments. Their operatives are expert divers, marine biologists, and submarine pilots, capable of operating in high-pressure environments that would crush standard equipment. Gamma-6 utilizes a fleet of specialized mini-sub and research vessels to investigate Unidentified Submerged Objects (USOs) and biological threats in the abyss. They deal with everything from leviathans slumbering in the Mariana Trench to anomalous ghost ships drifting in the Atlantic. Gamma-6 was deployed during the "Abyssal Bloop" investigation, where a low-frequency sonic anomaly was disrupting marine life across the Pacific. The team tracked the source to a dormant biological Titan on the ocean floor, successfully implanting sedation devices and establishing a monitoring perimeter without waking the entity, preventing a potential tsunami-level event.

Mobile Task Force Theta-5 "The Bigger Boat"

Designation: Naval Combat and Aquatic Defense Division

Primary Role: Surface Water Combat, Anti-Leviathan Operations, Naval Security

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Functioning as the Foundation's private Navy, **Mobile Task Force Theta-5 "The Bigger Boat"** operates a fleet of disguised destroyers, cruisers, and patrol boats. While Gamma-6 handles investigation and recovery below the waves, Theta-5 is deployed to destroy or turn back massive aquatic threats that breach the surface. They are equipped with advanced anti-thaumaturgic torpedoes, depth charges, and harpoon systems designed to restrain gigantic entities. Theta-5 often establishes exclusion zones in international waters, enforcing maritime quarantines around aquatic anomalies. Theta-5 was deployed during the "Leviathan's Wake" incident in the North Sea, where a colossal serpentine entity attacked a civilian oil rig. The task force engaged the entity with experimental concussive depth charges and high-caliber railgun fire, driving the creature back into the depths and enforcing a naval blockade until the creature was fully contained, saving the remaining rig crew and preventing an environmental disaster.

Mobile Task Force Alpha-4 "Pony Express"

Designation: Logistics and Secure Transport Unit

Primary Role: Transport of Anomalous Items, Courier Services, Supply Lines

Clearance Tier: 3 (Alpha-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Alpha-4 "Pony Express" consists of highly trained undercover operatives specializing in the secure transport of anomalies between Foundation sites. Unlike combat units, Alpha-4 operates completely within the public sphere, utilizing a vast network of disguised civilian vehicles, delivery trucks, and mail services. They are masters of route planning and logistical stealth, ensuring that Keter-class objects move through populated areas without ever being detected. Alpha-4 was deployed during the "Route 66" transfer, a critical mission to move a highly volatile, radioactive artifact across the continental United States. Despite being pursued by a rival Group of Interest, Alpha-4 operatives utilized decoy convoys and rapid route-switching algorithms to

evade interception, successfully delivering the package to Site-31 without a single civilian witnessing the high-speed chase.

Mobile Task Force Eta-5 "Jäger Bombers"

Designation: Large-Scale Aggressor Response Unit

Primary Role: Kaiju Combat, Gigantic Entity Neutralization

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Eta-5 "Jäger Bombers" is a rapid-response unit tasked with tracking and engaging "Large-Scale Aggressors" (entities over 30 meters in height). When an anomaly is too large for standard containment teams, Eta-5 is deployed to deliver overwhelming firepower. They specialize in high-yield explosive deployment, orbital bombardment coordination, and the use of experimental railguns. Eta-5 was deployed during the "Behemoth of Brasilia" event, where a 50-meter-tall biomechanical construct emerged near a population center. Coordinating with local air support, Eta-5 targeted the entity's leg joints with precision airstrikes and deployed "bunker-buster" sedatives, successfully toppling the giant and allowing containment teams to secure it before it could reach the city limits.

Mobile Task Force Lambda-4 "Birdwatchers"

Designation: Aerial Biological Containment Unit

Primary Role: Avian Anomaly Tracking, Skyborne Entity Retrieval

Clearance Tier: 3 (Alpha-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Lambda-4 "Birdwatchers" deals specifically with biological anomalies that are flight-capable. Unlike Sigma-9, which focuses on heavy aerial combat, Lambda-4 focuses on the tracking, netting, tranquilizing, and containment of anomalous flocks, flying cryptids, or airborne biological hazards. They utilize silent gliders, high-altitude drones, and specialized net-launchers to capture targets without causing a public spectacle. Lambda-4 was deployed during the "Starling Swarm" incident, where a million-strong flock of anomalous birds began attacking aircraft over London. The unit deployed a fleet of drones emitting a specific bio-acoustic frequency that disrupted the flock's hive mind, guiding them into a large-scale containment net

suspended by heavy-lift helicopters, thus reopening the airspace without firing a single shot.

Mobile Task Force Kappa-10 "Skynet"

Designation: Artificial Intelligence and Virtual Reality Unit

Primary Role: Cyber-Warfare, AI Containment, Digital Exorcism

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Kappa-10 "Skynet" is a unique division where many operatives are themselves Artificial Intelligences (AIs), virtual avatars, or uploaded consciousnesses. They patrol the Foundation's intranet and the immense landscape of the public internet to contain viral anomalies, rogue AIs, and infohazards. Kappa-10 is responsible for "digital exorcisms," trapping malicious code-based entities within secure servers before they can leak into physical hardware. Kappa-10 was deployed during the "Y2K-Plus" crisis, where a sentient malware attempted to seize control of global nuclear launch protocols. Kappa-10 operatives "dove" into the mainframe, engaging the malware in virtual combat and constructing a digital firewall around the launch codes, effectively quarantining the threat and deleting it bit by bit, silently saving the world from nuclear winter.

Mobile Task Force Mu-4 "Debuggers"

Designation: Electronic and Technical Containment Unit

Primary Role: Technology Manipulation, Signal Jamming, Hardware Retrieval

Clearance Tier: 3 (Alpha-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Mu-4 "Debuggers" focuses on the physical side of electronic and technological anomalies. If a computer starts bleeding, a server room becomes sentient, or a machine begins to rewrite reality, Mu-4 is deployed to secure the hardware and sever the connection. They are experts in electronics, coding, and signals intelligence, equipped with powerful EMP devices and signal jammers to neutralize techno-organic threats. Mu-4 was deployed during the "Ghost Signal" event at a broadcast station in Nevada, which was transmitting a visual cognitohazard to local televisions. The team physically breached the transmitter room while under heavy hallucinogenic influence,

cutting the hard lines and planting localized EMP charges to fry the anomalous equipment, halting the broadcast before it could reach a wider audience.

Armed Mobile Task Force Xi-8 "Spearhunters"

Designation: Sarkic and Archaic Threat Response Unit

Primary Role: Wilderness Tracking, Anti-Sarkic Combat, Primitive Weaponry Tactics

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Xi-8 "Spearhunters" is a specialized battalion dedicated to combating Sarkic (flesh-cult) entities and ancient biological horrors. Recognizing that modern ballistics are often ineffective against regenerative biomass, Xi-8 utilizes a mix of advanced tracking technology and archaic weaponry such as cold iron blades, silver-tipped spears, and high-tension crossbows. Xi-8 was deployed to the Siberian wilderness during the "Bone Orchard" investigation, where a feral Sarkic abomination was hunting local villagers. Eschewing firearms that only angered the beast, Xi-8 trackers lured the entity into a trap and engaged it with poisoned harpoons and ritual daggers, severing its regenerative nodes and effectively neutralizing the threat in a manner that modern firepower could not achieve.

Mobile Task Force Pi-1 "City Slickers"

Designation: Urban Environment Specialist Unit

Primary Role: Dense Urban Tracking, Rooftop Pursuit, Crowd Blending

Clearance Tier: 3 (Alpha-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Pi-1 "City Slickers" specializes in tracking, containing, and recovering anomalies in the world's most densely populated metropolitan areas, such as New York, Tokyo, and London. They are experts in parkour, urban camouflage, and social engineering, allowing them to navigate complex cityscapes unseen. Pi-1 was deployed during the "Neon Phantom" incident in Tokyo's Shibuya district, where an intangible entity was stalking commuters. Blending in as salarymen and street performers, Pi-1 operatives tracked the entity across rooftops and through subway tunnels. Using portable reality-anchors disguised as maintenance equipment, they

cornered the entity in an abandoned service station and contained it during rush hour without a single civilian noticing the operation.

Mobile Task Force Omega-12 "Achilles' Heels"

Designation: Reality Bending Counter-Force

Primary Role: Reality Bender Containment, Hume Level Stabilization

Clearance Tier: 4 (Beta-Class Interventional Authority)

Task Description:

Mobile Task Force Omega-12 "Achilles' Heels" is one of the Foundation's most potent and risky assets, composed of reality-bending personnel recruited from alternate universes or genetically modified stock. They are tasked with capturing hostile Green Type (Reality Bending) entities, using their own anomalous abilities to counter and stabilize local reality shifts. Omega-12 was deployed during the "Kingdom of Sand" manifestation, where a powerful reality bender had turned a small town into a personal fiefdom of glass and sand. Omega-12 operatives entered the distortion zone and engaged the hostile bender in a direct duel of will. By synchronizing their own Hume fields, they negated the bender's power, stripping him of his godhood and allowing standard containment teams to apprehend him, restoring the town to its original state.

List of Foundation Departments:

Intelligence Agency: The eyes and ears of the Foundation. This department tracks potential anomalies worldwide, intercepts communications, and monitors rival Groups of Interest (GOIs). They provide real-time intel and support to active Mobile Task Forces during missions.

Security Field Agents: Distinct from internal site security, Field Agents are stationed in the public sector to guard the perimeters of outside containment. They operate under civilian cover (police, private security, park rangers) to prevent civilian access to containment zones.

Ethics Committee: The internal judiciary of the Foundation. They dictate the "Code of Ethics," operational rules, and acceptable procedures for containment. They hold the power to veto containment procedures that are deemed excessively cruel or wasteful, ensuring the Foundation does not lose its humanity while protecting it.

Department of Anomalous Liaison (DAL): *Also known as the Office of Parahuman Affairs.* This department handles "Diplomatic Relations" with sapient anomalies. Agents here are negotiators and lawyers rather than soldiers. They conduct interviews, draft employment contracts for cooperative anomalies, and facilitate collaboration between the Foundation and benign anomalous communities.

Logistics Department: The backbone of operations. They handle the transport of resources, construction of containment cells, food supply for thousands of personnel, and the financial front companies that fund the Foundation.

Scientific Department (Researchers): The core of the Foundation's mission to "Secure, Contain, Protect." Researchers study anomalies to understand their properties, develop containment procedures, and occasionally develop counter-measures or weaponry based on anomalous principles.

Class-D Personnel: Recruited from death row or refugee populations, Class-D (Disposable) personnel are used for handling extremely hazardous anomalies where the risk of death or insanity is too high for professional staff.

Site Administration (Site Directors): The executive management for individual Foundation facilities. Site Directors coordinate all departments within their specific facility and report directly to the O5 Council.

The O5 Council (Overseers): The shadowy group of [X] individuals who have ultimate control over the Foundation. They determine the organization's broad goals, approve Omega-level threats, and maintain the secrecy of the Foundation's existence.

Command Center Personnel: The tactical coordinators who operate from centralized hubs. They monitor MTF body cameras, manage radio frequencies, coordinate airstrikes, and provide a link between field teams and Site Administration during crises.
